



## Woodland Forest Scarf

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Berroco Blackstone Chunky Tweed 4 balls at 60 yds each. (I purchased 5 balls of yarn).

Used 10-11 size needles depending on the drape you want.

CO 24 stitches.

The finished length is approx. 67 inches long. The width is approx 5".

Stitch Patterns:

1X1 Rib pattern:

\*K1, P1\* repeat each row

Seed Stitch:

Row 1: \*K1, P1\* repeat

Row 2: \*P1, K1\* repeat

Work rows 1-6 as follows:

Row 1 (RS): K1, P1, K1, P1, K1 then P1, K1, P1 then repeat \*K1, P1\* for the next 8 sts. P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1.

Row 2 (WS): K1, P1, K1, P1, K1 then K1, P1, K1 then repeat \*K1, P1\* for the next 8 sts. K1, P1, K1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1.

Row 3: K1, P1, K1, P1, K1 then P1, K1, P1 then repeat \*K1, P1\* for the next 8 sts. P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1.

Row 4: K1, P1, K1, P1, K1 then K1, P1, K1 then repeat \*K1, P1\* for the next 8 sts. K1, P1, K1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1.

Row 5: K1, P1, K1, P1, K1 then P1, K1, P1 then repeat \*K1, P1\* for the next 8 sts. P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1.

Row 6: K1, P1, K1, P1, K1 then K1, P1, K1 then repeat \*K1, P1\* for the next 8 sts. K1, P1, K1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1.

At Row 7 (RS): K1, P1, K1, P1, K1 then P1, K1, P1. Slip the next four sts on a cable needle and bring to the front. Work next four stitches on left needle in rib pattern, then return sts from cable to left needle and work in rib pattern. P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1.

Row 8-14: repeat Rows 2 and 3. Row 8 is the WS. Just repeat the same two rows until you're at row 15. Then do another cable.

At Row 15, repeat Row 7. Continue in this manner until the scarf is the length you desire.

To match this end to the other, work the same two rows for another six rows. Then bind off in pattern. Weave in the ends.
